Dear Mr. Sgarro:

By letter to the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) dated December 4, 2012, you submitted an affidavit dated December 4, 2012, executed by Mr. Rocco Sgarro, as Director, Regulatory Affairs, PPL Bell Bend, LLC (PPL), requesting that information in the following document be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 2, Section 2.390:

"RAI ENV-19 addresses water-related impacts as discussed in the Environmental Report (ER)"

Also, PPL provides a revised redacted version of BNP-2012-281 to NRC on March 1, 2013. A nonproprietary copy of these documents has been placed in the NRC's Public Document Room and added to the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Public Electronic Reading Room under ADAMS Accession No. ML123490007 and ML13073A149.

The affidavit stated that the submitted information should be considered exempt from mandatory public disclosure for the following reasons:

- (a) The information sought to be withheld from public disclosure is owned by PPL Bell Bend, LLC, its affiliates or third parties to whom PPL Bell Bend has an obligation to maintain its confidentiality and has been held in confidence by PPL Bell Bend, LLC.
- (b) The information sought to be protected is not available to the public to the best of your knowledge and belief.
- (c) The information is of the type that would customarily be held in confidence by PPL Bell Bend, LLC. The information that PPL Bell Bend, LLC is requesting to be withheld from public disclosure is in its response to NRC Request for Additional Information (RAI) ENV-19 regarding the Combined License Application (COLA) for the Bell Bend Nuclear Power Plant. That response discusses certain

commercial negotiations that PPL Bell Bend expects to enter into in the future regarding agreement(s) with third parties. PPL Bell Bend, LLC limits access to this information to those with a "need to know" subject to maintaining confidentiality. Public disclosure of this information at this time is premature and could significantly affect the ability of PPL Bell Bend, LLC to negotiate necessary agreements and compromises its negotiating position.

- (d) The proprietary information sought to be withheld from public disclosure is identified in the redacted version supplied with the response to RAI ENV-19.
- (e) The information is transmitted to the NRC in confidence and under the provisions of 10 CFR 2.390; it is to be received in confidence by the NRC.

The NRC has reviewed the revised letter dated March 1, 2013, and the affidavit in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.390 and, on the basis of your statements, has determined that the submitted information sought to be withheld contains proprietary commercial information and should be withheld from public disclosure.

Therefore, the version of the submitted information marked as proprietary will be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.390(b)(5) and Section 103(b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended. Withholding these documents from public inspection shall not affect the right, if any, of persons properly and directly concerned to inspect the documents. If the need arises, the NRC may send copies of this information to our consultants working in this area. We will, of course, ensure that the consultants have signed the appropriate agreements for handling proprietary information.

If the basis for withholding this information from public inspection should change in the future, such that the information could then be made available for public inspection, you should promptly notify the NRC. You also should understand that the NRC may have cause to review this determination in the future, for example, if the scope of a Freedom of Information Act request includes your information. In all review situations, if the NRC makes a determination adverse to the above, you will be notified in advance of any public disclosure.
