Dear Mr. Hanson:

On September 6, 2017, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) completed a security inspection at Three Mile Island Nuclear Generating Station, Unit 1. The NRC's inspectors discussed the results with Mr. Ed Callan, Site Vice President, and other members of your staff. The results of this inspection are documented in the enclosed report.

The NRC's inspectors documented three findings of very low security significance (Green) in this report. One of these findings involved a violation of NRC requirements. The NRC is treating this violation as a non-cited violation consistent with section 2.3.2.a of the Enforcement Policy.

If you contest the violation or significance of the violation, you should provide a response within 30 days of the date of this inspection report, with the basis for your denial, to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, ATTN: Document Control Desk, Washington, DC 20555-0001; with copies to the Regional Administrator, Region I; the Director, Office of Enforcement; the Director, Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response; and the NRC's resident inspector at Three Mile Island Nuclear Generating Station.

Two cross-cutting aspects were assigned to the findings in the areas of Problem Identification and Resolution and Human Performance. Specifically, Exelon failed to take effective corrective actions to address issues in a timely manner [P.3], and Exelon failed to ensure individuals follow processes, procedures, and work instructions [H.8].

If you disagree with a cross-cutting aspect assignment or a finding not associated with a regulatory requirement in this report, you should provide a response within 30 days of the date of this inspection report, with the basis for your disagreement, to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, ATTN: Document Control Desk, Washington, DC 20555-0001; with copies to the Regional Administrator, Region I; and the NRC's resident inspector at Three Mile Island Nuclear Generating Station.

Enclosure contains Sensitive Unclassified Non-Safeguards Information. When separated from the Enclosure, the transmittal document is decontrolled.
