Why are we holding public meetings?

Public meetings will serve the following purposes:

- introduce the proposed U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) regulations related to enhancing emergency preparedness (EP) requirements
- introduce NRC and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) draft guidance documents jointly and to explain the alignment of the documents
- answer questions about the proposed rule and draft guidance documents and to describe the next steps in the rulemaking process
- ensure openness during the EP rulemaking process
- provide additional opportunities for public participation in the EP rulemaking process
- build positive relations, confidence, and trust in the rulemaking process

This type of meeting provides an opportunity for the NRC, FEMA, and the public to work directly together to ensure that the NRC and FEMA understand and consider the public's issues and concerns. These meetings will provide opportunities for NRC and FEMA staff to answer questions about the proposed regulations and draft guidance; they are not forums to negotiate the content of the proposed rule or draft guidance documents.
